

Examination System

EVERY STUDENT SHALL COMPLETE 75 CREDITS IN A MINIMUM OF FOUR SEMESTERS. FIRST TWO SEMESTERS WILL HAVE 25 CREDITS EACH, THIRD SEMESTER WILL BE OF 10 CREDITS AND FOURTH SEMESTER WILL BE OF 15 CREDITS.

- Two semesters x 25 credits = 50 credits
- One semester x 10 = 10 credits
- One semester x 15 = 15 credits
- Four semesters total credits = 75 credits
- Two credits, one each in first two semesters, have been allocated for seminar. There shall be at least one seminar per theory paper. Marks out of 25 will be allotted for this.
- Six credits, in third semester have been allocated for recent trends in the pharmaceutical sciences.
- Total 7 credits have been allocated for the seminar on dissertation. Out of which 4 credits are for the seminar on research envisaged for dissertation in third semester and 3 credits are for the seminar on completed research work for dissertation prior to thesis submission in fourth semester.
- Eight credits have been allocated for the dissertation.
- Four credits have been allocated for the Viva-voce on dissertation.
- One credit = 25 marks; two credits = 50 marks and four credits = 100 marks.

FIRST TWO SEMESTERS SHALL HAVE 4 THEORY COURSES, 2 PRACTICAL COURSES AND 1 SEMINAR.

- 4 Theory courses x 4 credits = 16 credits
- 2 Laboratory courses x 4 credits = 08 credits
- 1 Seminar x 1 credit = 01 credit

Total = 25 credits
