Guidelines for the SRTMU Young Teacher Researcher Award

1.0 Preamble:

Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University wishes to institute **SRTMU Young Teacher Researcher Award** for the Full Time regular teacher working in different University Campus Schools and sub-campuses. The main objective of instituting the Young Teacher Research Award is to inculcate best research practices and to motivate young teachers of this university to deliver their best in the fields of Basic, Applied, Technology, Social and Humanity Sciences. This document provides the guidelines and proforma for the Young Teacher Research Award instituted by the SRTM University.

2.0 Nature of Award:

This award consists of a citation (signed by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor), a cash prize of Rs.10, 000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) and a memento.

3.0 Process of Application:

- 1. Applications, in prescribed format, should be submitted through proper channel on or before the last date of submission as per university circular.
- 2. The duly completed applications should be submitted to: The Deputy Registrar, APDS Section, S.R.T.M. University, Nanded 431 606
- 3. In *absentia* applications, applications not submitted in prescribed format or through proper channel will not be considered for the award.
- 4. Applications for this award should be invited at the end of every academic year (May).
- 5. Copies of necessary documents must be enclosed for proof of claim.

4.0 Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. This scheme will be open to the teachers from SRTM university campus schools, subcampuses, and affiliated colleges.
- 2. Teacher should hold permanent position (Full Time Regular Teacher) in any of the school/department of the main campus or the sub-campuses of S.R.T.M. University, affiliated colleges.

3. There will two separate awards;

- a. Category one: Teachers from campus schools and
- b. Category two: Teachers from affiliated colleges.
- 4. The award will be given for the best contributions in research conducted primarily during last five years.

5.0 Age limit:

This award will be given to a young teacher scientist, having age less than 45 years, who has made outstanding contributions in any area of Science, Management Sciences and Humanity Sciences.

6.0 Essential Qualification:

• Teachers, having good academic records at UG & PG levels and having Ph.D. degree, are eligible for this award.

7.0 Essential criteria for selection

- Teacher must have published at least two papers in peer reviewed journals.
- Preference should be given to journals having high impact factor and citations.
- Preference should be given to those teachers who have applied for financial support to funding agencies OR who are receiving financial support OR have completed at least one minor or major research project funded by any funding agencies.
- Preference should be given to those teachers who have collaborations with national and international institutes or have collaborative research scheme/projects or have research exchange program.

8.0 Selection process:

- The applications received in prescribed format and necessary documents will only be scrutinized by the scrutiny/selection committee.
- The selection/ scrutiny committee will invite shortlisted applicants for the presentation before the Selection Committee to highlight significance of the research work carried out by them, on the date announced by the University.
- The Selection Committee will then recommend name of selected teacher to the authority for conferment of the Award by the University.
- The name of the Awardee will be declared after completion of this process.
- The award will be bestowed on the occasion of University Foundation Day (17th Sept) celebration ceremony of this university.

Note:

- The selection committee has right to select/reject/invite applications of candidates.
- The decision of the University is final in all the matters of selection process and no correspondence will be entertained from the applicants.
- The award for a particular year may be withheld if no candidate of requisite merit is found suitable.
- In case applications are not received, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor shall make the nomination/recommend the name for this award.
