Information for students registering for MSc (Med. Phys) course

M.Sc.(Medical Physics) course is off-campus, involving expert faculty and expert professionals from different subject areas among various institutes within and outside of the Nanded City, such as Govt. Medical College, Nanded, Monark Cancer Hospital, Nanded, SGGs Engineering College, Vishnupuri, Pravara Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS), Loni, and Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. The students, on their own, will have to attend the classes and also carry out the lab work and Project work at these locations, as per time table provided by these institutes from time to time. It is mandatory to have 75% attendance in theory classes and lab courses.

Important: Procedure for admission

- After registration, students will have to appear for a qualifying test (Descriptive). The test will be based on the syllabi of Physics & Mathematics at B. Sc. Level. This written test will be conducted on 11th July 2016 at 10.30 am at School of Interdisciplinary Studies, SRTMUN.
- If they score minimum of 50% marks in this qualifying test, then students will be admitted as per University rules, based on their aggregate B.Sc. percentage.
- Result will be displayed on University website and admission process will be done within five working days.
