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01. University A Profile:-

Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University, Nanded has been carved out from Marathwada University, Aurangabad. Later it was renamed as Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. The purpose of Swami Ramanand Teerth University is to establish and promote facilities for advanced, applied education and research in the jurisdiction of the university that includes four districts namely Nanded, Parbhani, Latur, and Hingoli. This University has been considered a premier institution of Teaching, Learning, and research. The University was established on Sept.17, 1994 under Maharashtra University, Act. 1994 Section IV.

The Headquarter of this university is Nanded, a holy City situated on the banks of the river Godavari, the southern part of Maharashtra. This university has been named after Swami Ramanand Teerth, the Doyen of the Hyderabad Liberation Struggle and also renowned educationist, Social activist & beyond that a great Freedom Fighter. In a short Span of time the university has been granted recognition by the UGC Delhi, the apex educational body of govt. of India under 2 (f) and 12 (B) The university has been accredited with 'B' grade by the NAAC in Sept. 2010 and the 'A' grade in Jan 2015.

The University has visualized with non-conventional course with a school System for campus Teaching and learning to initiate and promote interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary studies. The university has redesigned and developed syllabi and courses that are characterized by innovative ways in teaching learning and evaluation with emphasis on the research aspect, consultancy and extension Services.

Right now the university has entered into Global perspective with a number of tools and products of higher education. Now the strength and number of affiliated colleges have gone up to 364 and total strength has reached about 1.50 Lakes with 14 postgraduate Schools on the campus with moderate, advanced and Technology based infrastructure. The university imparts education mainly in the faculties of Arts, Commerce, Management, science, Social Sciences, Education, Law, Pharms, Ayurveda, Medical, Engineering & Technology, Library Science, and Computational Courses & Mass Media. University started Sub-Center at Latur and Parbhani, New Model Degree College at Hingoli and Tribal Research Centre at Kinwat.

The efforts of the university, towards excellence in higher education are being recognized by the substantial grants received from the renounced funding agencies like UGC, ICSSR, DST, DBT, CSIR ,DRDO, DAE & DEC. The university has collaboration with other premier Institutions in Higher Education in India and abroad.

02. Directorate of Distance Education (External Mode), SRTMU Nanded :-

Distance Education (External Mode) is a generic term that includes range of teaching Learning Strategies variously described as home Study, Correspondences education or independent Study. It is a highly welcome step in the direction of taking education to the doors of those who are willing to acquire higher education but being unable to continue education due to lack of resources or paucity of time. Distance Education (External Mode) System fulfills the needs in Education to the distant learner who has been engaged in Service, business, working in the various fields and who has been a drop out of the education process. In India Distance Education Opportunists at the university levels have increased enormously. Most of the Conventional Universities have been running distance Education programs on the campus. Many new trends are putting great pressure on the conventional education Systems forcing many institutions to review their existing policies & procedure. In this light Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathawada University, Nanded took the decision to establish a Directorate of Distance Education (External Mode) (DDE) in 2009 a Directorate of Distance Education (External Mode) was setup in the administrative building of the University.

Currently Distance Education department running Undergraduate and post graduate programmes. There are three undergraduate courses like B.A., B. Com and BBA in a semester pattern as per the University Syllabus and examination pattern. Department also offer 12 post graduate courses like MA Marathi, Hindi, English, Sanskrit, Urdu, Political Sciences, History, Sociology, Public administration, Economics and Master of Commerce in External Mode under annual pattern.

From the last 5 years the growth in the registered students is tremendous. Last year near about 4000 students have been admitted for the post graduate courses run by the distance department.

03. Objectives of the Directorate Distance Education (External Mode):-To provide educational Facilities

- 1) To more number of learners from the various age groups.
- 2) To different section of the society who are unable to pursue education & to bring them into the main stream.
- 3) To the female class of the society who has remained deprived because of domestic responsibilities & Social restrictions.
- 4) To all sections of the society irrespective of caste, religion gender, area of origin, Social and financial status.

- 5) To maintain flexibility on academic and administrative aspects.
- 6) To impart and provide higher education opportunities particularly to the disadvantaged segment of the society.
- 7) To those who do not have direct access to face teaching working professionals & housewives.
- 8) To offer courses along with Self Instructional materials (SIM) contact Sessions, Counseling, facilities, Library & internet advanced technology in education through designated study centers.

04. The Advisory Committee:- This Committee has following functions.

- 1) The Committee is headed by the Vice-Chancellor.
- 2) The Committee includes the Statutory Officers of the University, eminent educational in the Jurisdiction of the university.
- 3) The Committee formulates Strategies and policies for academic and administrative issues pertaining to Distance education. (External Mode)
- 4) The Committee maintains unity, integrity and discipline in the System.
- 5) The Committee takes impartial decision for the benefit of the department.

05. Syllabus (SLM) Co. Ordination Committee:-

The Directorate of Distance Education (External Mode) at the University has formulated the Syllabus Co. ordination Committee that will design & develop the syllabus of distant/external mode and will also prepare the self-instructional material for distant learner.

- 1) The committee is headed by the Vice-Chancellor.
- 2) The Committee includes the Deans & chairmen of the Board of studies in Humanities, Social Service and commerce.
- 3) The Committee is responsible for designing and developing distance Education/external mode Syllabus for the approved courses and also shares while preparing study material as writer & editors.
- 4) The Committee Co-ordinates the writers, editors, while preparing Study material.
- 5) The committee attends & participates in the meetings, workshop discussions conducted by DDE.
- 6) The committees with the members of the Board of studies other experts design develop, write, & edit the syllabus Structure.

06. Features of the Courses: - The courses of the external education are characterized by the following features.

- 1) There is an encouragement for greater flexibility, diversity, accessibility, mobility and innovation in education at the University level by making full use of latest scientific knowledge & new educational technology.
- 2) There is Co. Operation between the existing Universities.
- 3) This Programme Mainly Focuses and Stresses For education to the adult men and women.
- 4) This is a welcome step in the direction of taking education to the doors of those who are willing to acquire higher education.
- 5) This System provides education for unreached, residing in urban, rural and remote area.
- 6) This System gives an opportunity to the adult learner who is willing to acquire higher education.
- 7) This System provides genuine flexibility in academic and administrative components of distance / external mode.
- 8) The Courses of distance / external mode are designed and developed by the Deans, Chairmen and members of Board of Students of the University.
- 9) The Self Instructional Material for the external learner is being made available.
- 10) Study Centres is functioning in the different colleges.
- 11) Academic and administrative aspects are implemented at the centre.
- 12) This Centre is connected through internet and academic as well as administrative information is uploaded at the web site.

07. The Study Centers:-

The university has identified study centers at the different colleges in the jurisdiction of the university. There are (59) for Post Graduate study centers and under graduate study centers. The admission procedure, examination, Counseling, group Discussion, Library reading and distribution of the study material all these activities are conducted at the study Centre. The study centres are allotted according to the norms of the university. The principal of the concern college works as head of the Study Centre and senior most teacher work as a Coordinator of the courses.

08. Registration and Eligibility:-

Registration and admission process is conducted at the Study centers. The Directorate of Distance Education (External Mode) advertises admission notice for all the approved programmes. Generally the admission process begins in the month of July every year. The admission schedule is uploaded on the website and the admissions are conducted accordingly. The admission forms are included in the prospectus and also uploaded on the website. After the notification the prospects are sold at the study centre. The student can select the nearby required study centre convenient for them. The students are required to confirm his/her eligibility as per admission eligibility criteria. The students are also required to submit the duly filled application form along with the necessary attested photo copies of each supporting document and required fees at the study centre. Filling of the examination form, examination fees, hall tickets all such activities will be conducted at the study centre. The students are required pay the fees as per the university schedule. The late fees facility is also made available by the centre. All the rules and regulations regarding admissions, eligibility criteria, admission fees, and examination fees are provided in the prospects.

Eligibility:-Criteria and General rules for admission

A male or female candidate residing in India or abroad who has completed 20 years of his/her age is qualified for admission to the course conducted by the DDE. The Distance/external learner is an adult person who is already engaged in service, business and any occupation and who has been deprived of his education.

(A) General rules & Eligibility criteria for UG and PG Courses :-

- A candidate who has passed his/her SSC/HSC examination conducted by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher secondary or other State.
- The candidate who has completed his UG Degree privately and regularly from the recognized colleges and Universities.
- A candidate who has acquired any UG or PG degree from the recognized universities is also eligible for appearing UG and PG in another discipline.
- A candidate who wants to appear for the PG programme privately is also eligible for the approved PG courses of this University.
- There is no maximum age limit for admission.

- A Candidate who has acquitted a PG degree from any discipline can appear for the courses in humanities social sciences Commerce from other university and Management run by distance education department.
- There is no need of gap Certificate during admission.
- There is no restriction of submission of migration certificate.
- A Candidate can avail facility of dual degree system in one academic year.
- The degree from distance/external education of this university is considered equal to conventional degrees for the central and state Govt. competitive examination and its various sectors.
- A Candidate is not required to produce original T.C. Mark memo or Cast Certificate during the admission of any course.
- From the academic year 2019-2020 no semester system of M.A. examination is implemented for the External mode. An annual examination pattern once in a year during holidays will be conducted by the department.
- A Medium of Language for writing answer sheets during the examination will be Hindi /Marathi or English.
- A Candidate who wants to improve his educational standard for getting B+ has to pay double amount of the fees.
- The learners are required to receive and study the self-learning material prepared by the study centre.
- It is mandatory for the study centres to conduct counseling sessions of the students as per this schedule.
- From the academic year 2019-2020 the PG students of distance/external mode are required to submit a research report or term paper work basically depend open field work having 100 marks.
- Every year there will be inspection, assessment of the academic and administrative programmes conducted by the study centres.

The learner of the open and distance education is an adult learner, who is engaged in service and business and who is unable to attend college, university regular classes due to his job, service and profession. These learners are unable to give sufficient time like the regular students in conventional system. The distant learners of this university are adult learners. The centre for distance education, SRTM University, Nanded has been developing syllabus and self learning material based on distance mode.

- Counseling, guidance of the expert in the contact session
- Group discussion, presentation, question bank.
- Practical if required.
- Provision of photo copies of the topics in the prescribed books.

14. Syllabus of External Education:-

The Department of Distance Education/External Mode of SRTM University has developed the syllabus for the external education with the help of Deans and the chairmen of the Language, Social Sciences, Commerce and experts in the colleges of this region.

These committees initially, designed and developed the curriculum for the M.A. Programme in humanities and M. Com programme in Commerce. The deans, Chairmen Members of the BOS of various subjects and the expert professors took pains taking efforts to design and develop the syllabus for subjects. The M.A. programme, during the academic year 2016-2017 consists of Marathi, Hindi, English, Sanskrit, Urdu ,History, Sociology, Political Science, Economic, Philosophy and Public administration. The development of M. Com Programme syllabus is started in the academic year 2019-20. The detail syllabus is available at the University website for further references

15. Contact Sessions and Counseling:-

The Coordinator of the Study Centre in consultation with the head/Principal should conduct contact sessions course wise and paper wise. The Study Centers are expected to send the copy of the contact session time table to head office and also expected to maintain attendance of the student, staff accordingly. The study centre must be well equipped with furniture, electricity, water supply, seating arrangement library, computer and internet and these facilities should be provided to the learners. The contact sessions must be conducted in the vacation, on holiday and after office hours. The subject wise, period wise and teacher wise time table should be prepared. The counsellors are not expected to teach and arrange lectures but they are expected to provide discussion, two-way communication on the points

they would be discussing. The teacher and learners should have interaction based on the points delivered. The table of the contact sessions is shown below.

Besides Counseling the counsellor is expected to arrange guest lecture, group discussion, presentations, field visit field work during the contact session.

16. The Self Learning Material (SLM) :-

This self-Learning Material is the key factor in Open and distance education. The distance learners, mostly, depends upon the self-Learning material provided to them at the study centres because this material plays the role of teacher in every sense Previously the self-learning material was not provided to the distance learners as they had to rely on the Course material of their conventional Syllabus. But for the academic year 2017-18, we have been preparing the Self learning material for the M.A. Part one and Part Two programme in the subjects of Marathi, Hindi, English, Urdu, History, Sociology, and Political Sciences, Public Administration and Economics, Each part of M.A. Programme Consist of four papers as we call them blocks, so the total blocks for the M.A. Part one and Two will be 36 blocks respectively. Hence we are printing and producing blocks for the M.A. part one and part two. These books will be circulated among the study Centres for the admitted distance learners of external mode.

The Self learning material for the M. Com programme will be produced and printed in the current academic year and will be delivered as early as possible.

17. Examination and Evaluation procedure:-

For the post graduation course Master of Arts annual pattern examination system has been adopted. Each paper university examination will be 100 marks. Each subject having 100 marks theoretical examination out of that for passing it is necessary to secure 40 marks in each subject. There is no any internal examination. For ATKT there are 25% rule is applicable.

Nature of Question Paper

- **For Undergraduate and Post Graduate Courses: (Semester Pattern):**The Nature of Question paper is same like the traditional courses run by the University in a regular Mode

- **For Postgraduate Courses:** As per follow
 - There are total five questions carrying 20 marks each.
 - Question No. 1 to 4 will be having internal choice within each questions
 - Question no. 5 will be short notes having 4 short notes (any two to be attempted)

Standard of Passing:

- **For Undergraduate and Post Graduate Courses: (Semester Pattern)** The standard of passing is same like the traditional courses run by the University in a regular Mode
- **For Postgraduate Courses (Annual pattern)**
 - The passing standard of course as per the University's External course pattern.
 - The external assessment shall be based on the term end written examination to be held at the end the year for each paper/course.
 - University examination passing standard will be 40%
 - All other rules of A.T.K.T. grace etc. will be applicable as per university external course pattern.

18. Dual degree provision:-

A Student can keep terms simultaneously for two examinations of this University provided that the student can take regular admission for one of the courses conducted by the University and for another examinations he /she should keep terms under distance education external mode and further provided that there no overlap clash between examination Schedule of the two examination A candidate willing to apply to keep terms for two examinations and details furnishing information about second course that he/she wants to complete..

19. The Infrastructure facilities :-

The University runs the Distance Education external mode study centre at the varies academic colleges in its jurisdiction. The infrastructure of these study centres is adequate and depends upon the modern and technical facilities. These study centres are well equipped with the classrooms, computers, Internet and Library. The admission, counseling, seminars, discussion and examinations are conducted at these study centres. The distance external mode learner is expected to attend all these activities at the study centre. He/she is not expected to contact at the distance education department in the University.

20. Learning resources: - The Distant external mode learners are provided the following learning resources at the Study centre.

- Counseling, Library-reading, guest-lecturers group-discussion, presentations, audio video acts made available to the learners in various faculties.
- The syllabus & SLM Co-ordination committee have designed and developed the syllabus of M.A. programme based on DE principles in humanities and social sciences.
- Besides this, the committee is writing SLM on the basis of the IGNOU
